### **Bonneville 750 T140J 1977**

To coincide with celebrations in Britain marking the 25th year of Queen Elizabeth II's reign, Meriden hit on the idea of a special edition of the Bonneville.

It's distinctive trim featured silver, as well as patriotic red, white and blue. Originally it was announced that the Jubilee Bonneville would be made in a limited edition of 1000 and the first batch side panel badges bore the legend " One of a Thousand "

However, demand for the machine was sufficient to persuade the Cooperative to release a further 1000 T140 J's with the wording altered to read " Limited Edition ". A further batch, generally agreed to have been about 400 machines, were produced for the International market, being Canada, Australia and New Zealand. The wording on the side panel badges, again being altered to read " Limited International Edition ". Each machine was sold with a certificate of authenticity.
